

## The Woodfield Teaching School Alliance

Our numbers of School Direct Trainees has increased, as Brent schools are finding it more difficult to recruit, and are beginning to understand that 'growing their own' is a robust succession planning option.

The additional benefit for schools working with the Woodfield Teaching School Alliance is that all trainees have a school experience in mainstream and special, a unique feature of the Woodfield TSA. All our mainstream strategic partners also have an additional resource for SEND pupils. All three strategic partner special schools are outstanding, offering a broad range of learning opportunities for trainees. In 2014/15 we lost our allocated places when the lead school for IT went into RI. Woodfield is now the lead school and the allocated places have risen from 29 to 42 for 2017-18.
