Priorities for the Governing Board

For the remainder of the academic year, the board is focussed on increasing its capability to effectively support the school and all within the school community assisting the school in delivering the best outcomes for all pupils.



Woodfield School is part of Compass Learning Partnership, a charitable company limited by guarantee (company number 8905350, registered in England and Wales) that has its registered office at Woodfield School, Glenwood Avenue, Kingsbury, London, NW9 7LY We have three key priorities for this:

- 1. Ensure that all positions on the board are filled.
- 2. Ensure all board members are trained as appropriate.
- 3. Ensure the board becomes more proactive and visible in school life.

Parent Governor Positions

Bearing point 1 in mind, we currently have three parent governor positions to fill within the governing board and I would like to invite nominations for these positions.

Parent governors play a vital role on an effective Governing board, being a representative parent (rather than a representative of parents) and providing the unique viewpoint offered to them as a parent through the first-hand experience of the children, using this to inform school management strategy.

Depending on the number of nominations we receive, an election may need to be held and further information on this process will be provided to nominated Governors and the school community in due course as required.

Increasing Visibility of the Governing Board

Aside from strengthening the voices on the board, we are also looking to create more visibility of the board, and its activities. We are currently investigating ways the board can become more involved in the activities at the school, bearing in mind current restrictions, and we will also be looking to update the Governor page on the website to include names, pictures and/or biographies for you to refer to.

As we complete board skills audits, I will also look to see what can be done to proactively provide expertise directly to the school community, whether directly through a Governor or through the expertise in their network. So do watch this space.
