Dear Parents and Guardians,

We have a rule in school called 'an arm's length.'

This rule is teaching the children that they must respect each other's personal space. This rule also applies to the adults in the building. We would like children to respect adults' personal space. This rule also helps children understand that no touching is allowed at school. Please make sure that you help us to reinforce this rule and help your child to understand why it is important at school.

We are keen to make sure that our attendance is up to the required level. Please make sure that your child is in school every day unless they are unwell. If your child's attendance falls below 90% you will receive a letter telling you this- but if it falls below 85% you will need to come into school and bring documentation to support the absences. I'm afraid we cannot authorise any holidays or time off school for any reason.

Homework- If homework is not handed in at the correct time; children get a chance to complete the homework in the library where they receive help from an adult. Children that fail to give in homework will receive a detention. It is a school system that applies to every child. If your child is not receiving homework please let me know and I can find out what is happening.
