Behaviour and Bullying at Woodfield- I have been asked by our Parent Group to investigate how much bullying goes on at Woodfield. As we are also working towards achieving the Anti Bullying Kite Mark we can put this evidence forward. In the Autumn Term 2013 we have had 20 incidents of bullying by 9 children and 13 of the incidents concerned 2 children. This is 4.41% of the total number of behaviour incidents that occurred in KS3 and KS4. We will take further action to ensure we reduce this small percentage in the Spring Term and stamp out bullying at Woodfield. I will report to parents and governors each term.
