Careers learning

- From Y7 to Y14, you will have career education embedded within the curriculum to help you understand your options after school, the world of work, the job market and the skills you might need for the future
- We will support you to carry out enterprise projects each year
- Pathway 2 pupils have formalised careers lessons.
- We will help you to link what you learn in your subjects at school to careers and the workplace.
- We will provide an array of opportunities for you to listen to and talk to visitors from los of different industries.
- We will work with The Shaw Trust to provide each leaver with a mentor to support them in the future goals and ambitions.

Advice

- You will always have someone to talk to about your future plans, for example, your form tutor or the careers team at Woodfield School
- Whichever year group you are in, you can request a meeting to talk through your ideas and hopes for the future with a fully qualified, impartial careers adviser. If the careers adviser is not in school, you can speak to the Mrs Deorukhka or Miss Wood.
- Your parents can be invited to attend these meetings too.
- Careers advice can be given during PLP days and Annual Reviews also.

- Throughout your time at school, you'll have chance to gain work experience; meet employers, colleges, further education and apprenticeship providers and have a go at work-related
- Once in KS4 and KS5, you will have a work placement that runs once a week, every week. We have many placements to choose from and we will continue to expand these offers.
